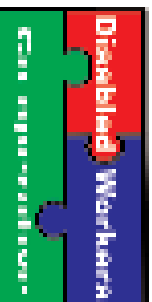

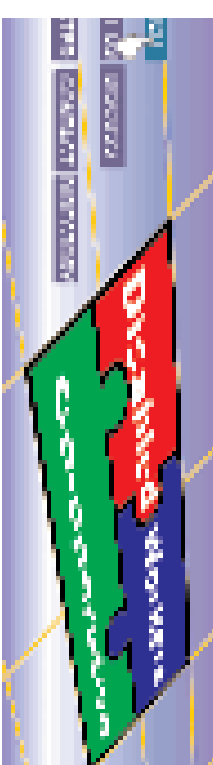

The Disabled Workers Co-operative is a new not-for-profit organisation that aims to create a national database that will match the needs of individual customers with a local disabled person who is able to provide whatever product or service the customer needs.

Local disabled people fulfilling local needs.

Our aim is to develop and improve the earning potential of disabled individuals offering a product or service.

Our project will increase awareness of the skills, abilities and worth of disabled workers throughout the country.

For many skilled, disabled people it is not being able to work that is the problem; it is the impracticality of getting to and from work or finding new customers.

Unemployment is highest amongst disabled people than any other group. The problem may be discrimination by employers against employing a disabled person or simply the problems involved in getting to work.

Register FREE!

The Disabled Workers Co-operative supports the work of individual disabled workers, organisations and companies employing disabled people in meaningful paid employment.

FREE registration for all **self-employed disabled homeworkers**. It is NOT necessary to be "registered disabled" as long as you have a disability and can provide evidence to support this.

FREE registration to non-profit making organisations i.e. Sheltered Workshops and Charities, employing or supporting the employment of disabled people.

Commercial companies, may also apply, providing they are employing a significant number of disabled people in meaningful **paid employment**.

You don't need a website to register.

All you need to do in return is to promote **The Disabled Workers Co-operative** to your customers. As more people use the site the more likely it is that someone will find the services you're offering.
