

Unemployment is highest amongst disabled people than any other group. The problem may be discrimination by employers against employing a disabled person or simply the problems involved in getting to work.




### Why not search the Disabled Workers Co-operative Database.

### The Disabled Workers Co-operative supports the work of individual disabled workers, organisations and companies employing disabled people in meaningfu paid employment.

**FREE registration** for all **self-employed disabled homeworkers**. It is NOT necessary to be "registered disabled" as long as you have a disability and can provide evidence to support this.

**FREE registration** to **non-profit making organisations** i.e. Sheltered Workshops and Charities, employing or supporting the employment of disabled people.

Commercial companies, may also apply providing they are employing a significant number of disabled people in meaningful paid employment.

You don't need a website to register.

All you need to do in return is to promote The Disabled Workers Co-operative to your customers. As more people use the site the more likely it is that someone will find the services you're offering.
